<b>Venue:</b>	Circolo Lucchese Croquet, Lucca – Tuscany

<b>Events:</b>	<b>The “Coppa del Serchio”</b> Open Singles, Flexible Swiss. All play to WCF rules for Golf Croquet current at the start of the tournament.	
<b>Entries:</b>	Up to 16 – two places will be reserved for Italian players	
<b>Entry Fees:</b>	Championship - <b>€ 15.00</b> Entry fees may be paid at the Club during the event. No credit cards accepted.	
<b>Entries:</b>	Close 14 <sup>th</sup> September, 2013, allocation of places will be on a first-come-first-served basis. Entries may be accepted after 14 <sup>th</sup> September if places are available.	
<b>Format:</b>	The tournament will consist of at least 4 rounds of 13 points single games, scheduled according to a Flexible Swiss format, followed by a play-off among the top four players. Double banking will be used depending on the number of players and on time restrictions.	
<b>Lawn conditions:</b>	The tournament will be played in a historical villa within the city of Lucca, so the lawns will be less-than-perfectly-flat.	
<b>Time Limits:</b>	Time limits will not be imposed in the Championship unless absolutely necessary.	
<b>Accommodation:</b>	Expected hotel rates in Lucca are as follows: - Single en-suite room: <b>€ 90.00</b> - Double en-suite room: <b>€ 110.00</b> including breakfast. Hotel San Marco ( <a href="http://www.hotelsanmarcolucca.com/">http://www.hotelsanmarcolucca.com/</a> ) is suggested.	
<b>Gala Dinner:</b>	A Gala Dinner for the players and their companions will be held on Saturday night: it will cost about <b>€ 35.00</b> ; please confirm your attendance when sending your entry.
